



# MAINTAINING YOUR CONDITIONAL OFFER OF ADMISSION



for the 2012-2013 academic year

If you received a conditional offer of admission, it means you must satisfy certain conditions in order to keep your admission offer. This conditional offer is also based on your mid-term or interim grades, and so we must receive your final grades **by August 15** in order to confirm the admission offer.

**Students must arrange for their official transcript with final grades to be forwarded to Admissions Services as soon as it is available. Those who do not forward their grades risk having their offer withdrawn and their registration deleted.**

Once we receive your final grades, we will reassess your application to ensure that you still meet the requirements for your program. If you no longer meet the required averages, we will have to withdraw your offer. Where it is possible we will give you an alternative offer of admission.

If you received a conditional offer, you must:

- meet the program requirements detailed in this flyer in order to retain your offer of admission. Each program has specific requirements, including overall and prerequisite averages, so please review the chart carefully. If you have any questions, please contact Admissions Services.
- successfully complete the requirements for your high school diploma.
- accept your offer of admission by the deadline indicated on your offer in order to reserve your space in the program. If you do not respond by the deadline, it could result in your offer of admission being withdrawn. If you accept your offer by the deadline, we will send you information on registering for your courses.

<b>Bachelor of Architectural Studies</b>	70%	English, Physics and one senior-level university preparatory Math course
<b>Bachelor of Arts (Honours and General)</b>	70%	<b>All programs</b> require English with a minimum final grade of 60%. For Biology: Chemistry with a minimum final grade of 60%. For Economics: One senior-level university preparatory Math course with a minimum final grade of 65%.
Exception: Global Politics	80%	
<b>Bachelor of Commerce</b>	75%	Minimum final grade of 60% in English. One senior-level university preparatory Math course with a minimum final grade of 70% and one other senior-level university preparatory Math course.
<b>Bachelor of Computer Science</b> Honours Major	75% 70%	Minimum final grade of 70% in one senior-level university preparatory Math course.
<b>Bachelor of Engineering</b> Aerospace	80%	Minimum final average of 80% in one senior-level university preparatory Math course, Physics, Chemistry and one of: a second senior-level university preparatory Math course or Biology.
Architectural Conservation and Sustainability, Mechanical, Engineering Physics, Biomedical and Mechanical, Sustainable and Renewable Energy	75%	Minimum final average of 75% in one senior-level university preparatory Math course, Physics, Chemistry and one of: a second senior-level university preparatory Math course or Biology.
Biomedical and Electrical, Civil, Communications, Computer Systems, Electrical, Environmental, Software	71%	Minimum final average of 71% in one senior-level university preparatory Math course, Physics, Chemistry and one of: a second senior-level university preparatory Math course or Biology.
<b>Bachelor of Humanities</b>	72%	No prerequisites required.
<b>Bachelor of Humanities with Biology</b>	72%	Minimum final grade of 60% in Chemistry.
<b>Bachelor of Industrial Design</b>	70%	Minimum final average of 65% in Physics and one senior-level university preparatory Math course.
<b>Bachelor of Information Technology</b>	70%	Minimum final average of 70% in English, one Science course and one senior-level university preparatory Math course.
Exception: Photonics and Laser Technology	70%	Minimum final average of 70% in English, one senior-level university preparatory Math course, senior level Physics and one senior level Science course.
<b>Bachelor of International Business</b>	78%	Minimum final grade of 60% in English. One senior-level university preparatory Math course with a minimum final grade of 70% and one other senior-level university preparatory Math course.
<b>Bachelor of Journalism</b>	82%	Minimum final grade of 70% in English.
<b>Bachelor of Mathematics (Honours)</b>	75%	Minimum final average of 70% in two senior-level university preparatory Math courses.
<b>Bachelor of Mathematics (General)</b>	70%	Minimum final average of 65% in two senior-level university preparatory Math courses.
<b>Bachelor of Mathematics (co-op)</b>	75-85% depending on the stream	Minimum final average of 75% in two senior-level university preparatory Math courses (math average 80-85% depending on stream).
<b>Bachelor of Mathematics/MSc</b>	85%	Minimum final average of 90% in two senior-level university preparatory Math courses.
Exception: Biostatistics	75%	Minimum final average of 75% in two senior-level university preparatory Math courses, Chemistry and Biology.
<b>Bachelor of Music</b>	70%	No prerequisites required.
<b>Bachelor of Public Affairs and Policy Management</b>	78%	No prerequisites required.
<b>Bachelor of Science (Honours)</b>	75%	Minimum final average of 70% in one senior-level university preparatory Math course and two of: Biology, Chemistry or Physics.
Exceptions: Applied Physics, Physics (Experimental and Theory), Double Honours in Math and Physics	75%	Minimum final average of 70% in two senior-level university preparatory Math courses and one of: Biology, Chemistry or Physics.
<b>Bachelor of Science (General and Major)</b>	70%	Minimum final average of 70% in one senior-level university preparatory Math course and two of: Biology, Chemistry, Physics or a second senior-level university preparatory Math course.
<b>Bachelor of Social Work</b>	70%	No prerequisites required.
