

Carleton University Winter Contest

Winter 2026

The Contest Period

The Carleton Winter Events Prize Contest ("the Contest") is run by the Undergraduate Recruitment Office at Carleton University. The Contest applies to eligible participants who register for and attend designated Carleton University winter recruitment events. Entries will be collected throughout the winter events period and the draw will take place on May 6, 2026.

Eligibility

To be eligible to enter the Contest, an individual must:

- Be a resident of Canada.
- Be in grade 12 and have applied or will apply to Carleton University
- Have reached the age of majority in their province or territory of residence, or have the consent of a parent or legal guardian.
- Not be a current student or employee of Carleton University.
- Not reside with, or be an immediate family member of, an employee of Carleton University.
- Residents of Quebec are not eligible to enter this Contest.

How to Enter

Eligible participants may enter the Contest by scanning the official QR code provided at designated Carleton University winter recruitment events and completing the online entry form. Each participant must register and attend at least one eligible event in order for their entry to be valid. The more events you attend, the more chances of winning (entries) students will have. There is no fee to enter. No purchase or other consideration is required. Late or incomplete entries will not be accepted.

Win one of three \$500 prizes!

Three lucky students will each receive a \$500 CAD prize, selected by random draw.

If you win and are registered as a student at Carleton University in Fall 2026, the \$500 will be added to your Campus Card balance at the start of the term. You can use your Campus Card funds to pay for:

- Textbooks, Carleton swag, and supplies at the Campus Store
- Food and drinks at campus cafés
- Printing and other eligible on-campus purchases

Please note: The prize has no cash value and cannot be withdrawn as cash, transferred, or exchanged.

Draw Date and Winner Notification

The random draw will take place on May 6, 2026. Selected winners will be contacted using the contact information provided at the time of entry. If a selected entrant cannot be reached, does not respond within five (5) business days, or is unable to accept the prize as awarded, their entry will be deemed void and an alternate eligible entrant may be selected.

Awarding the Prizes

The Undergraduate Recruitment Office will apply the prize amounts directly to the winners' campus card for the Fall 2026 term once enrolment is confirmed. The decision of the Undergraduate Recruitment Office with respect to all aspects of the Contest, including the selection of winners, is final and binding.

Disqualification

The Undergraduate Recruitment Office reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who provides false or misleading information, tampers with the entry process, or violates these rules. Any such determination will be made at the sole discretion of the Undergraduate Recruitment Office.

General Terms and Conditions

- All entries are subject to verification by the Undergraduate Recruitment Office.
- Incomplete or fraudulent entries will be void.
- The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.
- Prizes must be accepted as awarded and are not transferable.
- The Undergraduate Recruitment Office reserves the right to substitute a prize with another of equal value if circumstances beyond its control make this necessary.

By entering this Contest, participants agree to be bound by these official rules and the decisions of the Undergraduate Recruitment Office.

Termination of Contest: The Undergraduate Recruitment Office reserves the right, in their sole and absolute discretion, to modify, cancel, terminate, or suspend the Contest at any time, in whole or in part, in the event of any cause or circumstance, including without

limitation any virus, computer bug, or unauthorized human intervention, unauthorized or automated voting, or any other cause that is beyond the control of the Undergraduate Recruitment Office that could corrupt or affect the administration, security, impartiality, or normal course of the Contest.

Release and Exclusion of Liability: By entering or attempting to enter the Contest, each individual agrees: to release, discharge, and forever hold harmless Carleton University, and their respective officers, directors, employees, members, agents, and other representatives (collectively, the “Releasees”) from any and all claims, actions, damages, injuries, demands, manner of actions, causes of action, suits, debts, duties, accounts, bonds, covenants, warranties, indemnities, claims over, contracts, and liabilities of whatever nature or kind including without limitation arising out of, or in connection with the entrant’s participation or attempted participation in the Contest, compliance or non-compliance with these Contest rules and acceptance and use of the Prize, any other prize or any portion thereof.

Carleton University will not be responsible for lost, incomplete, late, or misdirected Contest entries or for any failure of the Contest website during the Contest Period, or for any technical malfunction or other problems with, any telephone network or lines, computer online systems, servers, access providers, computer equipment or software, or for any technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet, or at any website, or any combination of the foregoing, and will not be liable for any resulting injury or damage to any person or property arising from, or relating to, that person’s or any other person’s participation or attempted participation in the Contest, or attempted voting in the contest. Any attempt to deliberately damage any website or to undermine the legitimate operation of this Contest is a violation of criminal and civil laws and, should such an attempt be made, Carleton University reserves the right to seek remedies and damages to the fullest extent permitted by law, including criminal prosecution. Each winner must sign a release form, giving Carleton University the permission to publish in print, broadcast, or online, the winner’s name without remuneration.

Communication with Entrants: No communication or correspondence will be entered into with any Contest entrants about their specific contest entries, other than with winning entrants selected by the contest judges.

Personal Information and Privacy Policy: Any personal information collected through this Contest will be used and disclosed by Carleton University under the authority of the *Carleton University Act*, and in accordance with sections 39, 41, and 42 of Ontario’s

Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act and applicable Carleton University privacy policies, which can be read here: carleton.ca/privacy/privacy-policies. By entering this contest, all individuals consent to the collection and use of the personal information provided and contained in any submitted entry. The information provided will not be used for any purposes other than those stated upon this form unless the entrant directs otherwise. Carleton University is fully compliant with FIPPA and endeavours at all times to treat all personal information in accordance with this law.
